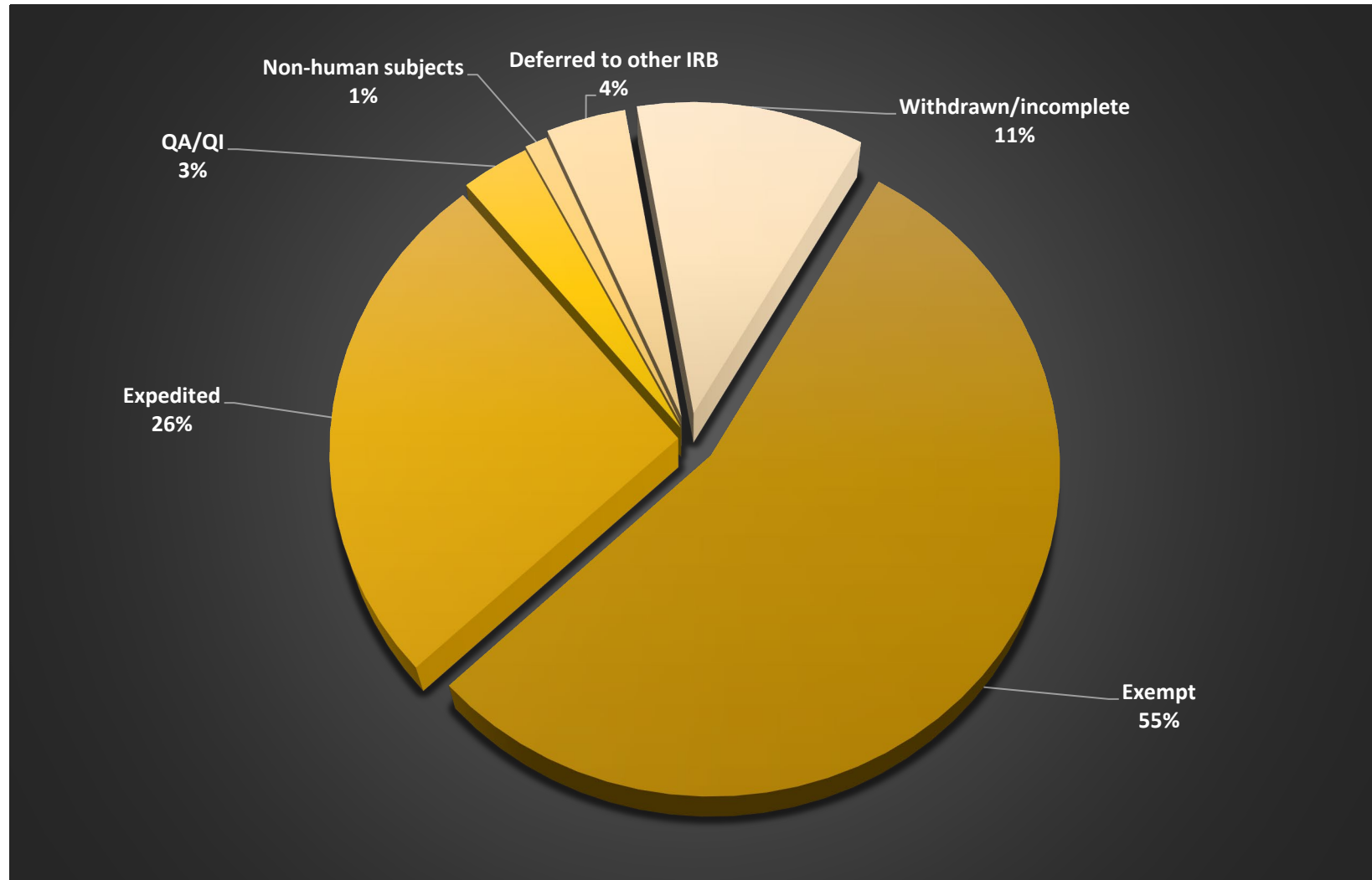

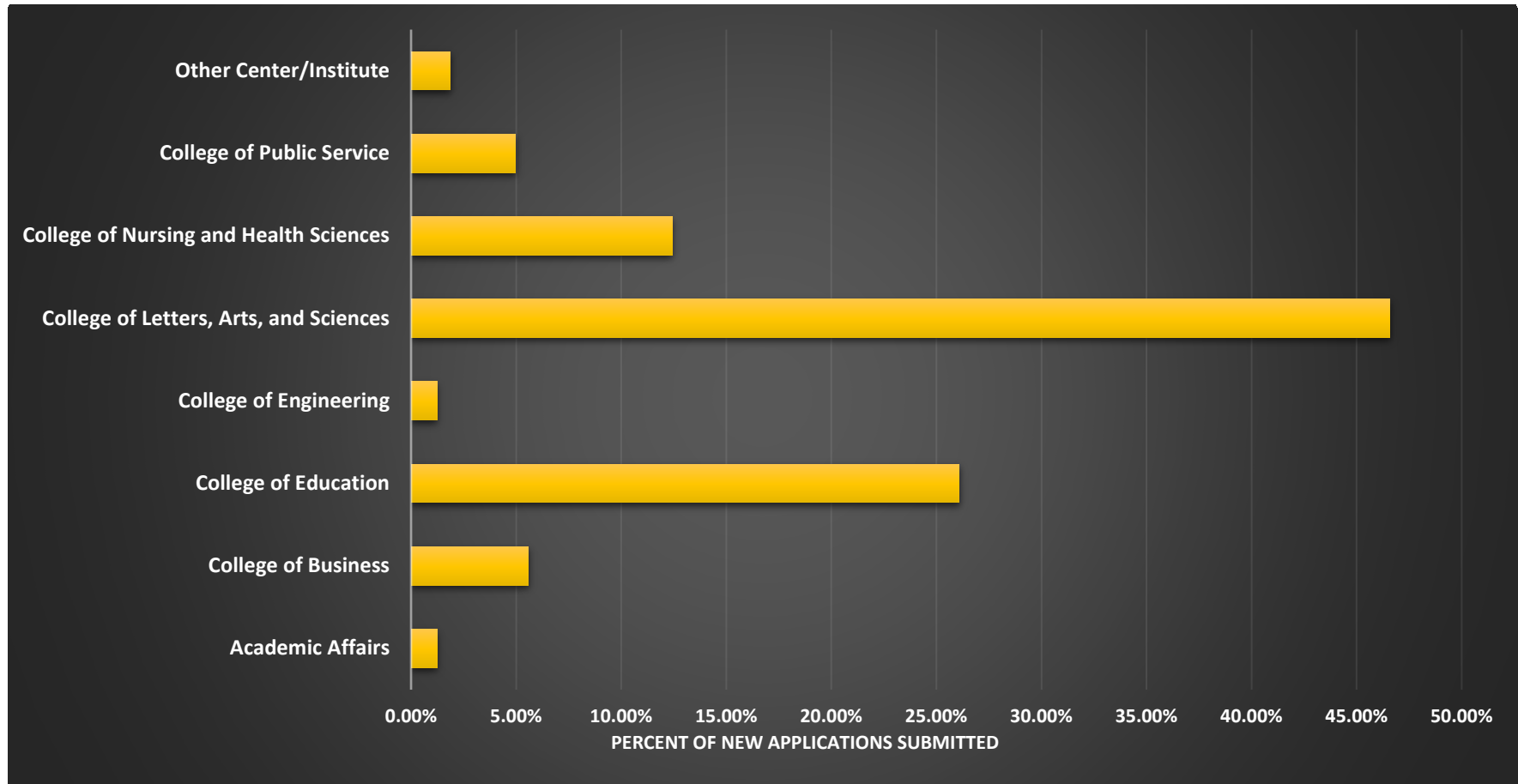

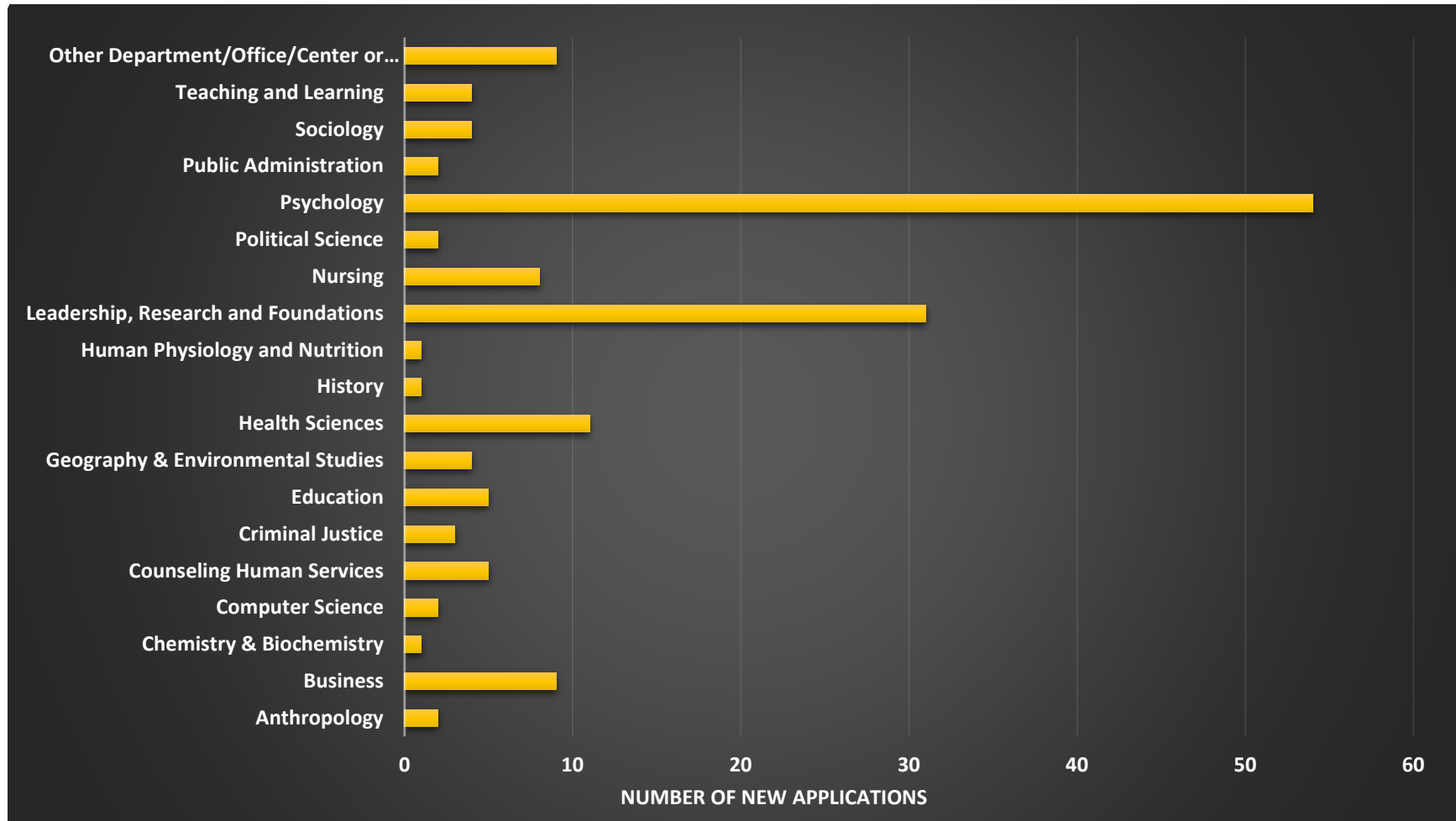
FY 2023 New Application IRB Review Level



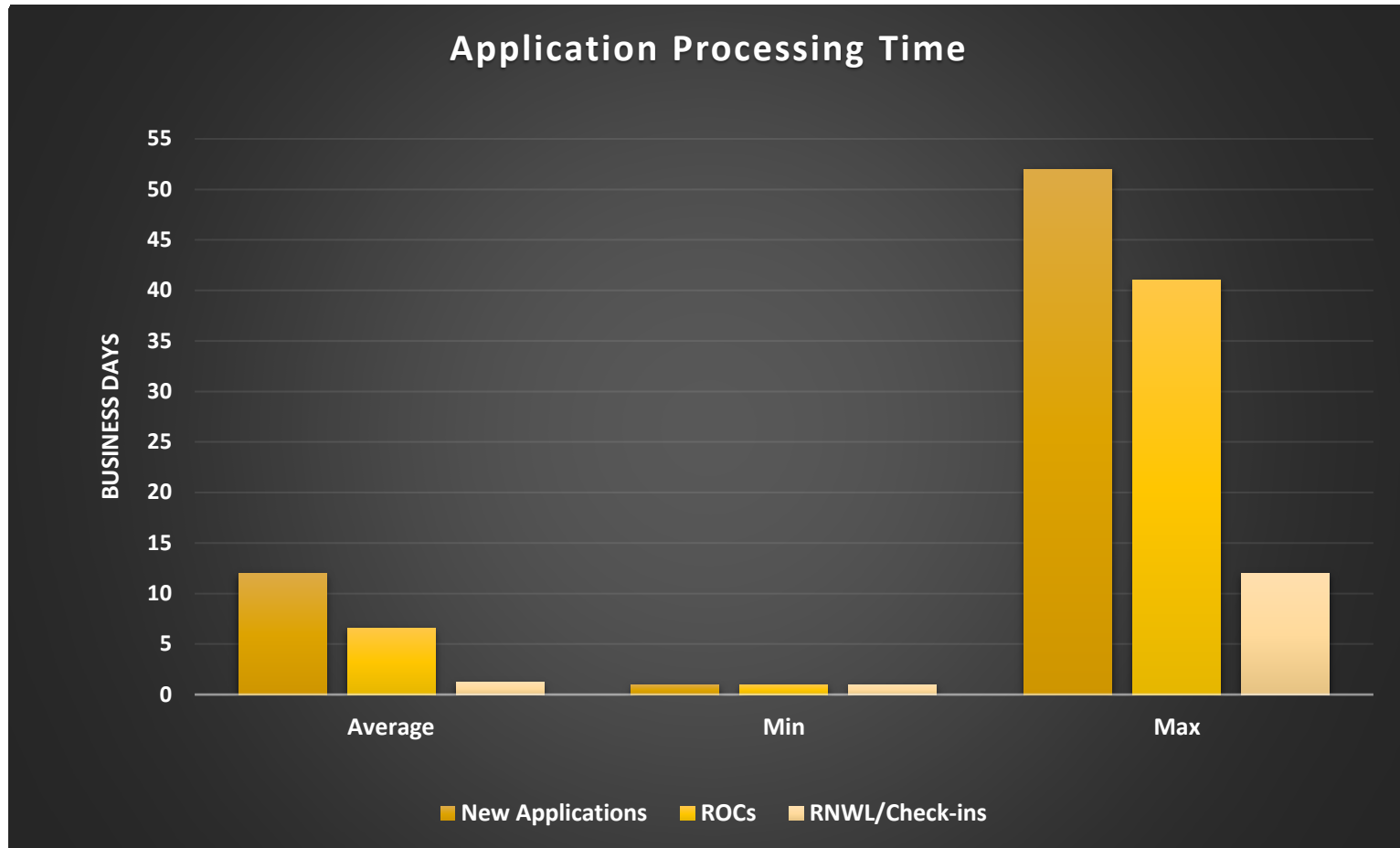

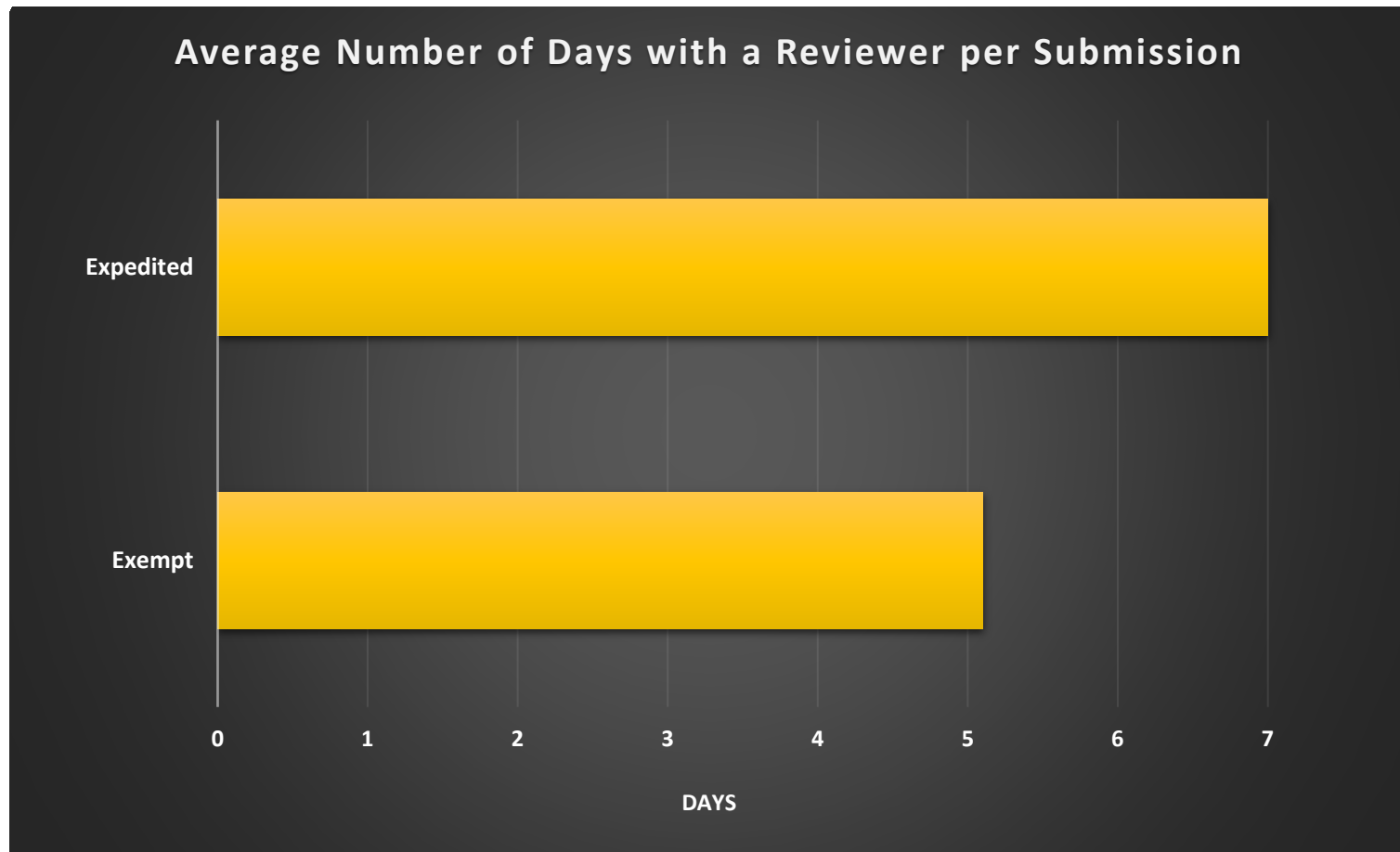


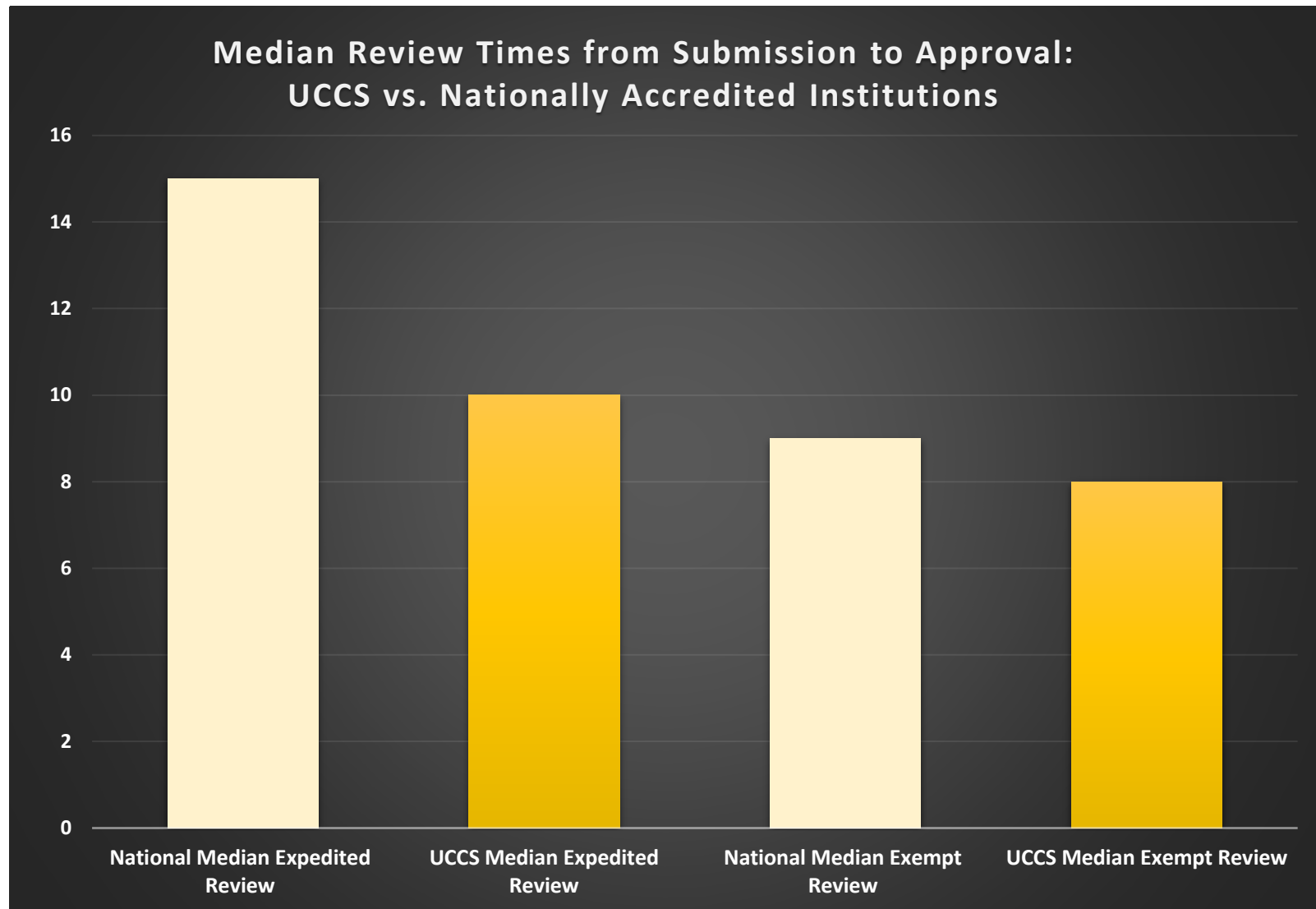
Applications by Department



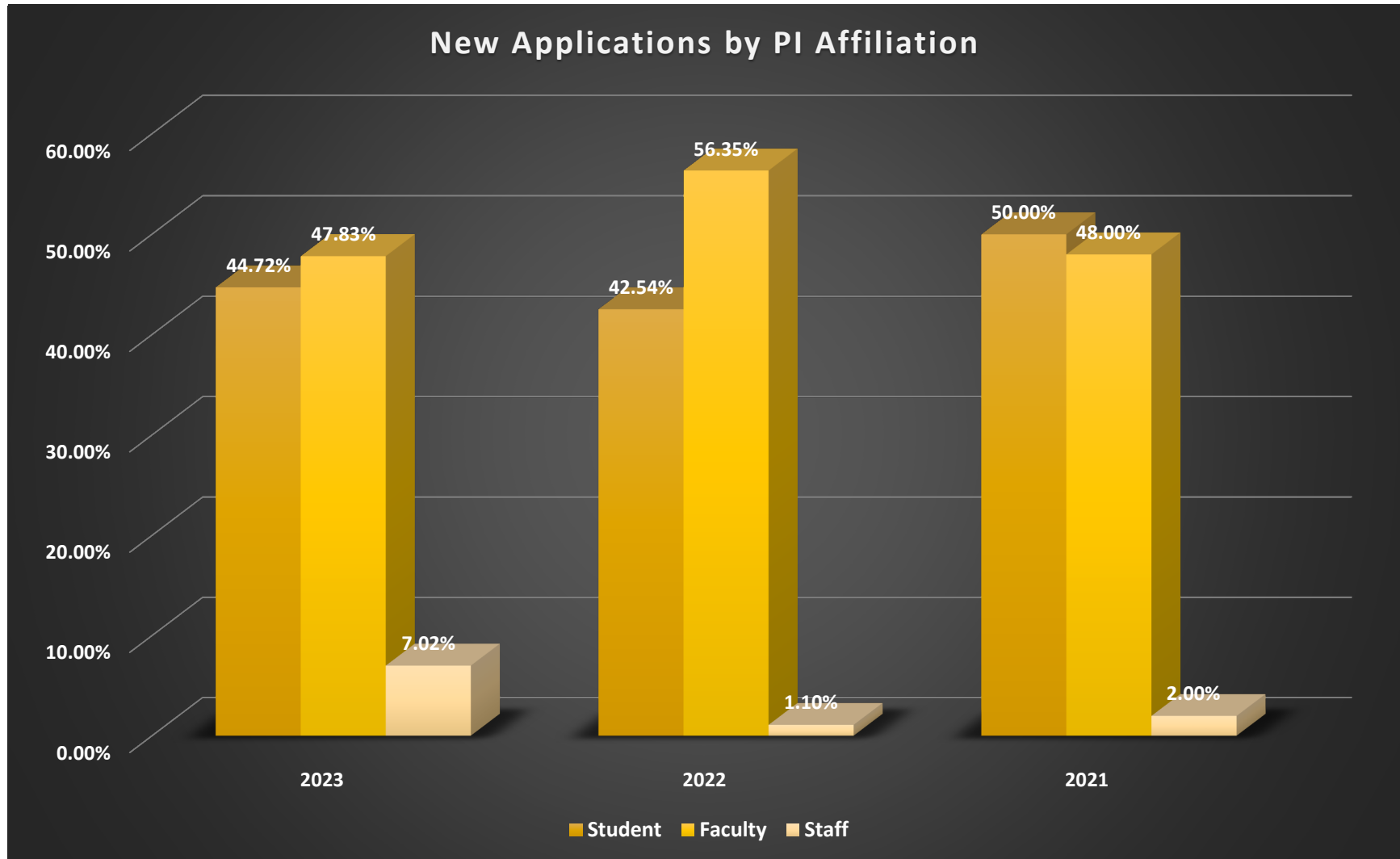

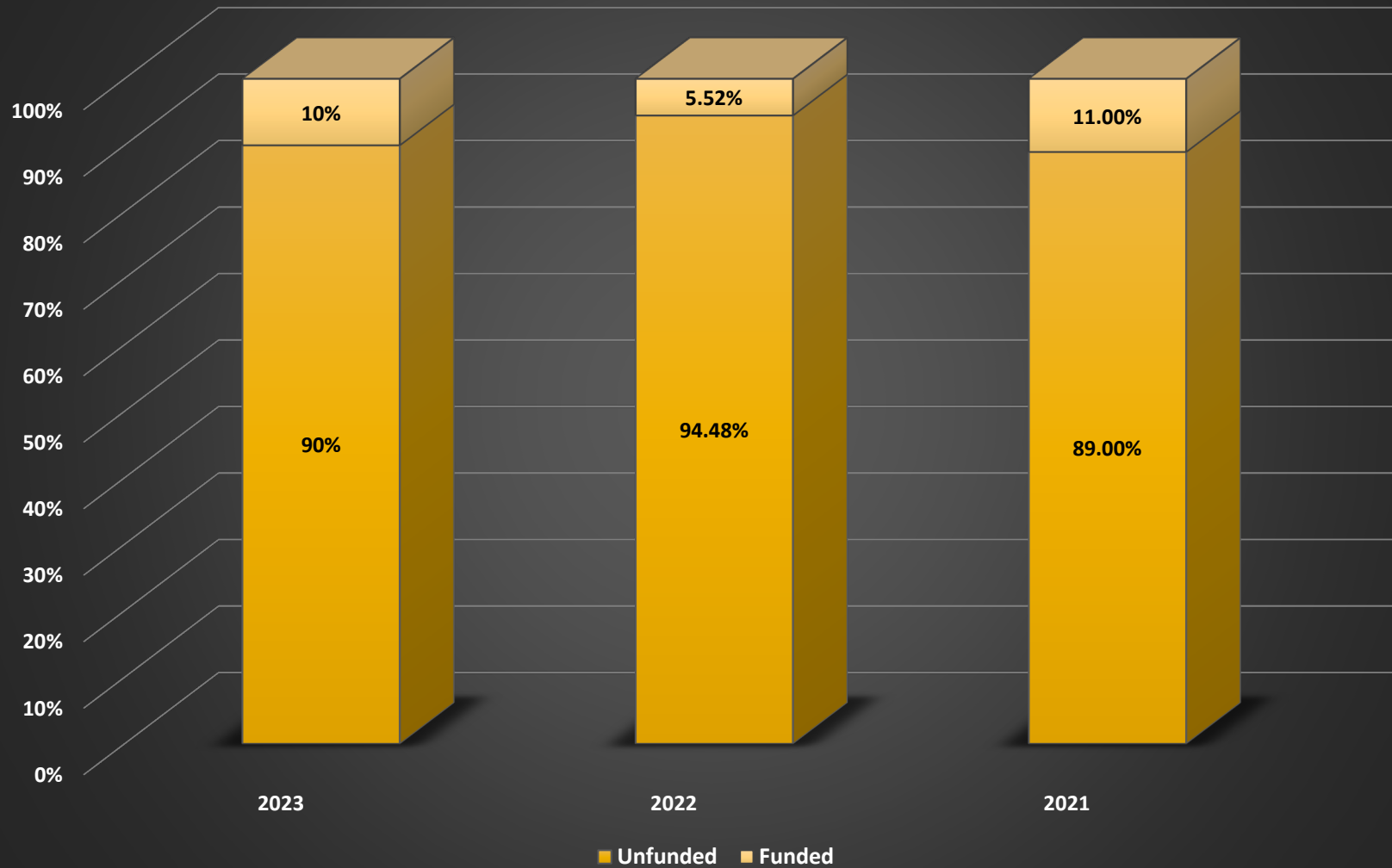

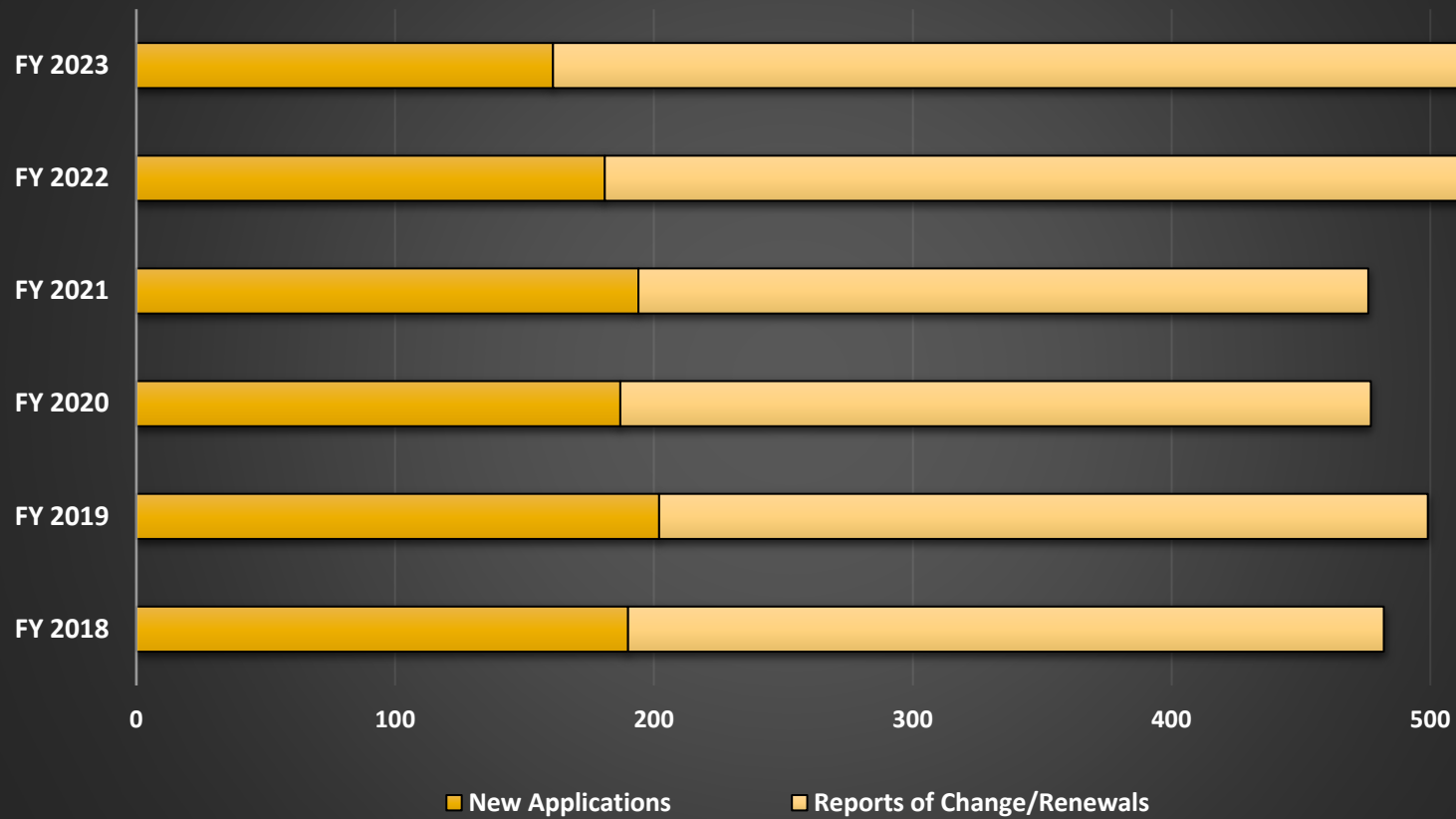


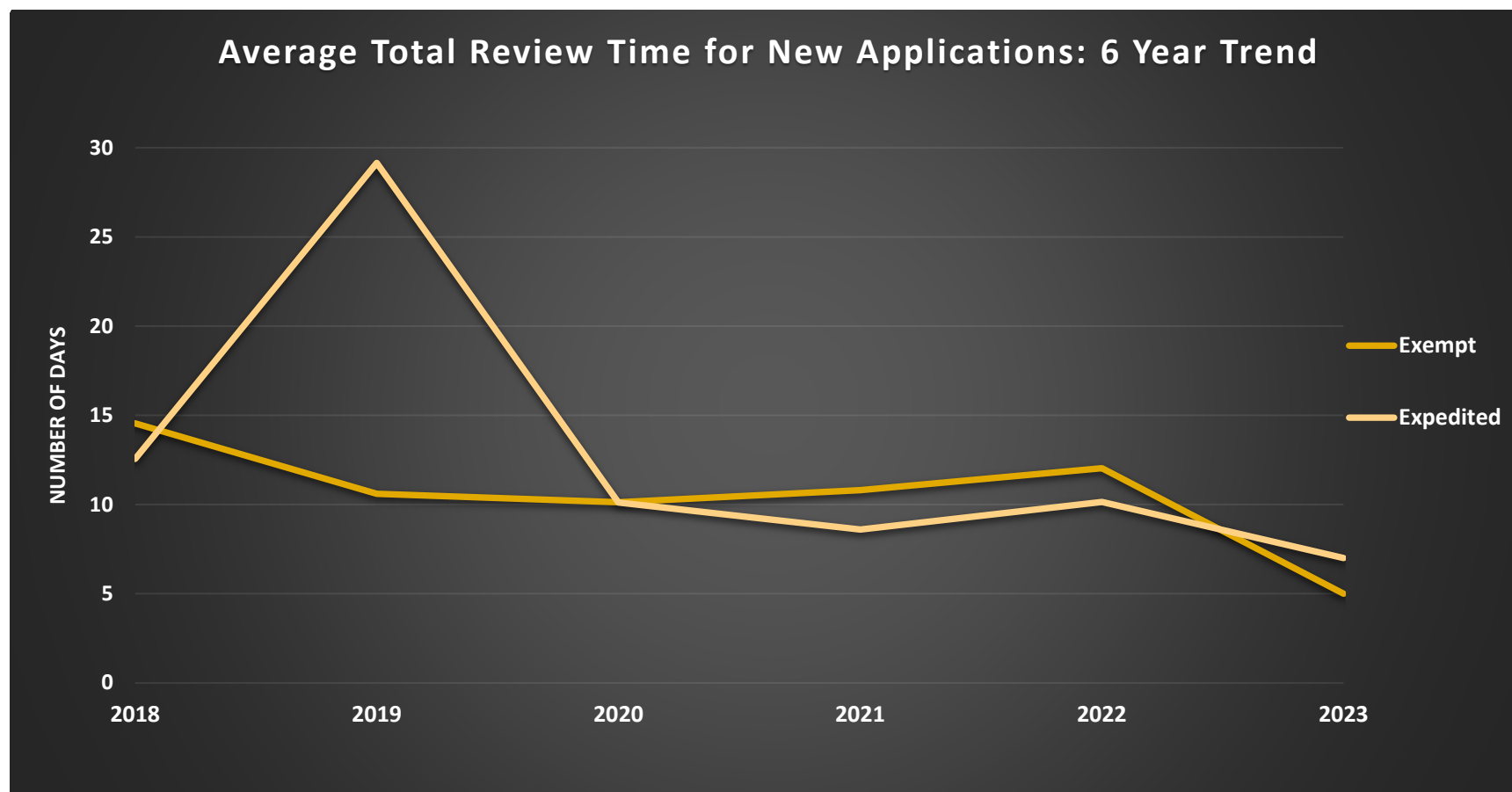
Funded vs. Unfunded New Applications



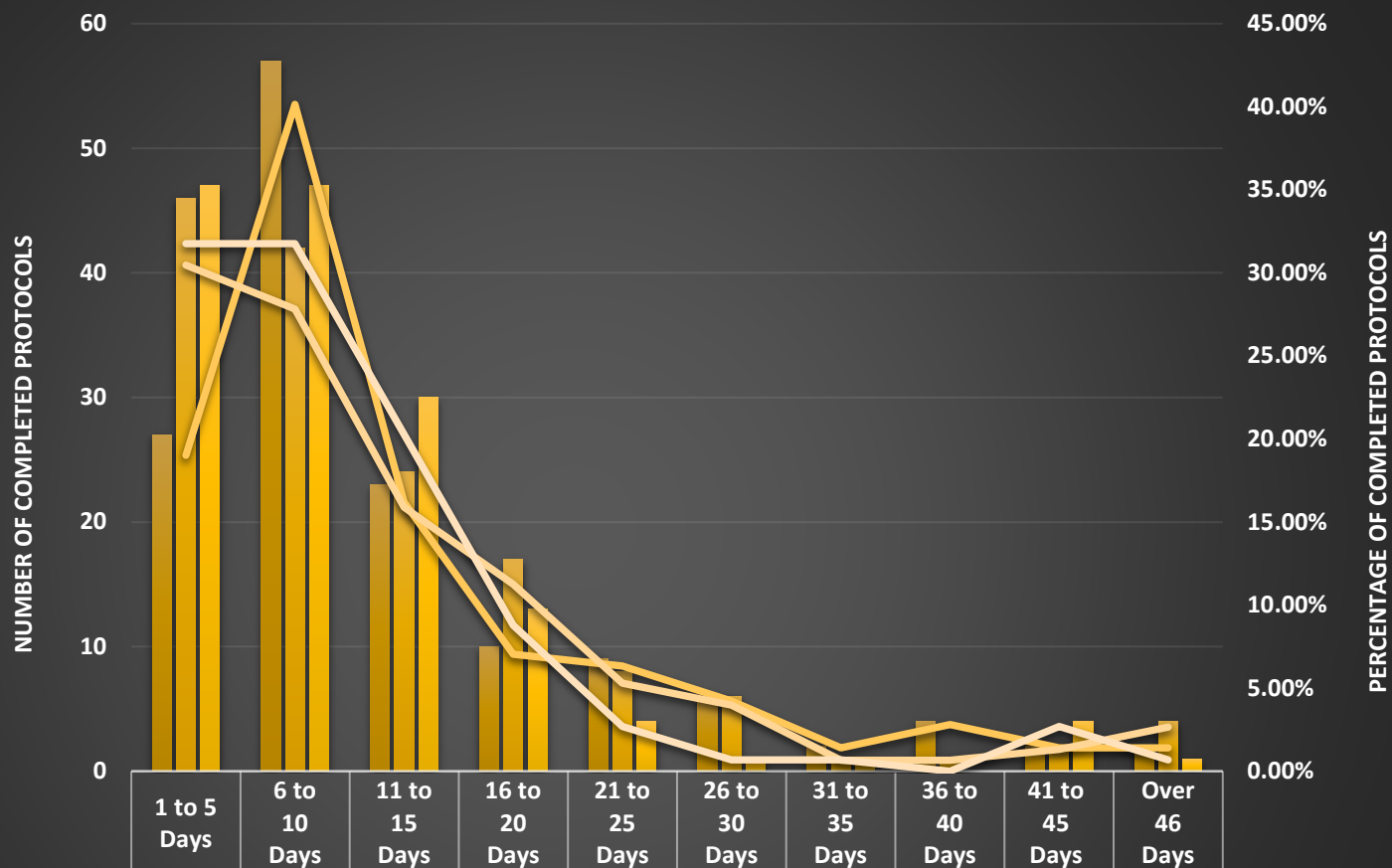


IRB Applications Received Last 6 Years

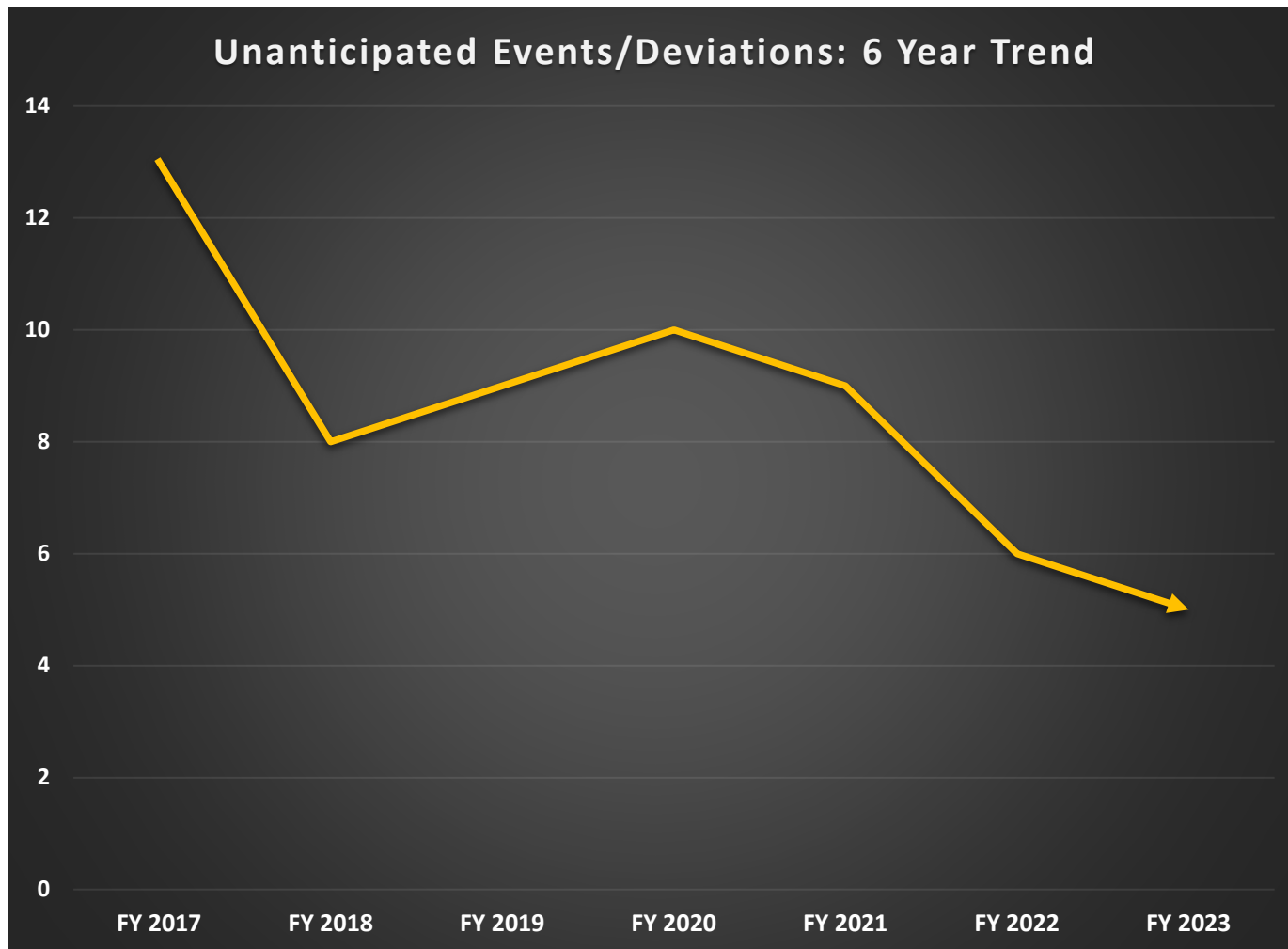

Facts

- 649 active protocols
