

Academic Affairs Distribution of Facilities and Administrative (F&A) Recovery from Externally Sponsored Programs

F&A recoveries (formerly referred to as ICR) by Academic Affairs are used to create and sustain an infrastructure for research and sponsored programs activity.

Campus F&A

Total VCAA F&A (i.e., 25% of F&A per campus policy #900-003) recovered by the campus will be distributed to the VCAA's organization as follows:

Office of Research and Office of Sponsored Programs and Research Integrity: 75% of F&A recoveries are allocated to the OOR and OSPRI to support research related activities including, but not limited to, personnel, compliance costs, and funding to support faculty and student research.

Graduate School: 15% of F&A recoveries are allocated to the Graduate School to support research activities including, but not limited to, responsible conduct of research training, student engagement in research, student related travel, and graduate student research assistantships.

Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs: 10% of F&A recoveries are allocated to the Provost to support research activities, including but not limited to, cost sharing associted with some sponsored programs, personnel costs, and funding to support faculty and student research.

Unit F&A

F&A funds recovered by Academic Affairs as a unit (i.e., 40% provided to unit receiving award) will be divided between the VCAA, the supporting Office, and the principal investigator. The VCAA will retain 25%, the Office providing grant administrative support will be given 50% and the PI will be given 25%.
