

**Center for Student Research - Distribution of Facilities and Administrative (F&A)
Recovery from Externally Sponsored Programs
Revised June 21, 2022**

The Center for Student Research will participate in the distribution of F&A recoveries in the following manner:

- (a) When a sponsored program is submitted by an Associate whose primary appointment is in a School or College, and the Center provides primary support for grant development and provides administrative support for the funded project, one half of the indirect costs normally allocated to Colleges will accrue to the Center and the other half to the Associate's College
- (b) When a grant is submitted by an Associate whose primary appointment is in a School or College, and the Center provides significant support in developing and obtaining the grant, but the grant is supported administratively in the School or College, then the Center and College will negotiate sharing the indirect cost recoveries prior to grant submission using the forms on the OSPRI website; or
- (c) When a grant or contract application is submitted by an Associate whose primary appointment is in the Center, then the full amount of indirect costs will accrue to the Center.

In all cases, the Principal Investigator on a grant will have the authority to determine whether the College or Center will provide pre and/or post award administrative services to the project. All fully executed F&A MOUs or F&A distribution plans will be honored.

F&A funds recovered by the Center for Student Research (i.e., 100% allocated to the unit per policy 900-003) will be divided between the Center, the supporting administrative office, and the principal investigator as follows:

- The Center will retain 50%
- The Office providing grant administrative support will be given 20%
- The PI will be given 30%.
