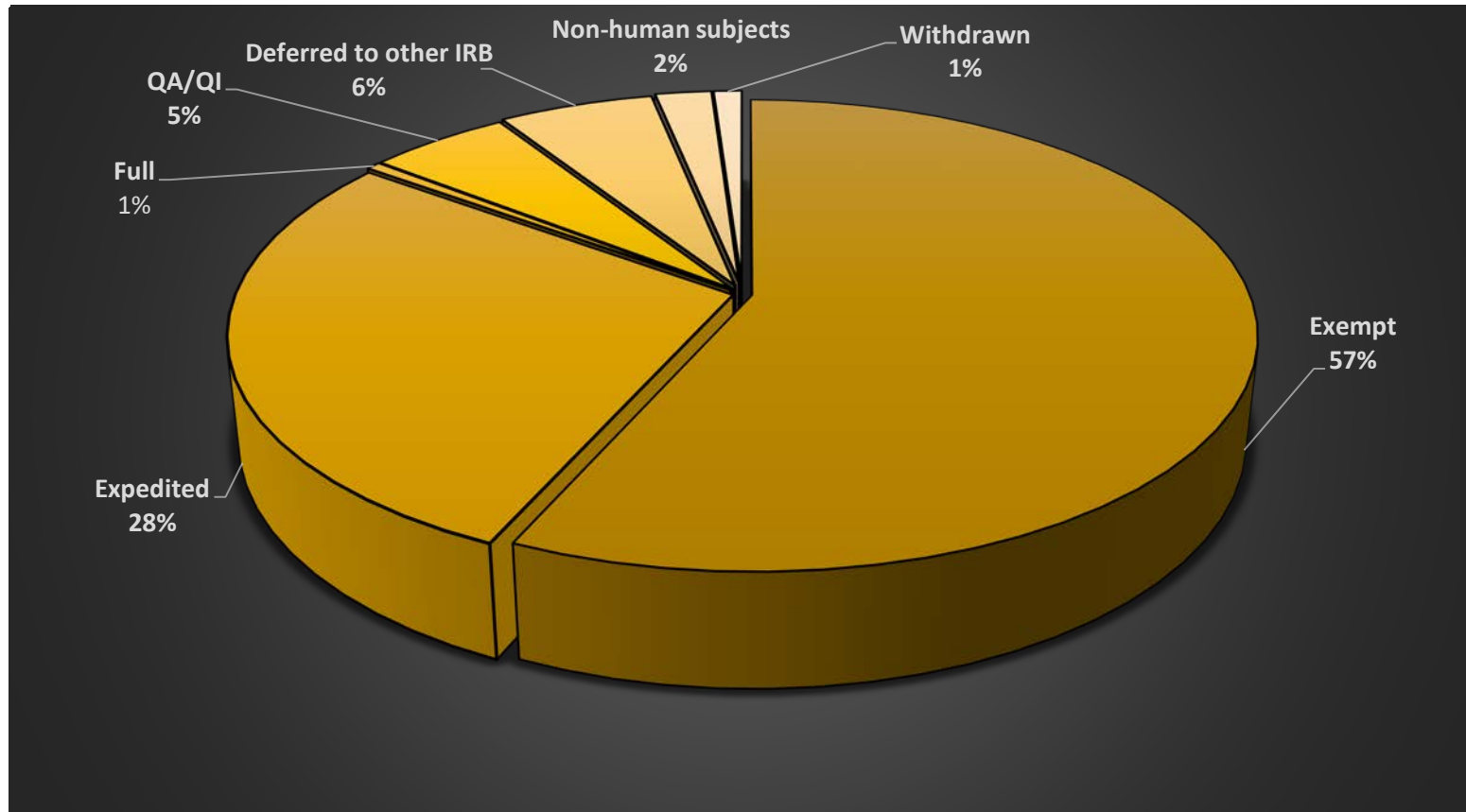

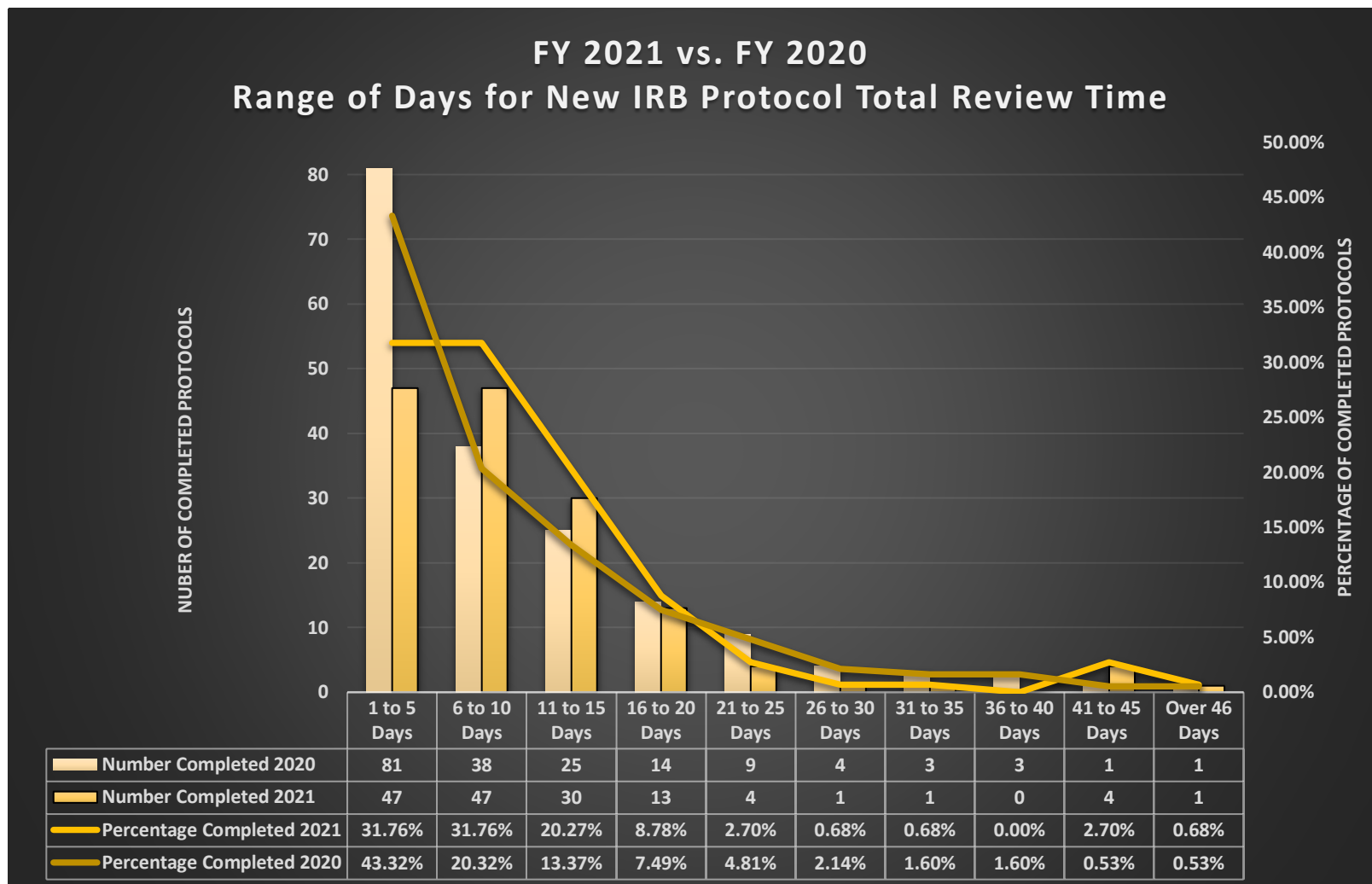
FY 2021 New Application IRB Review Level

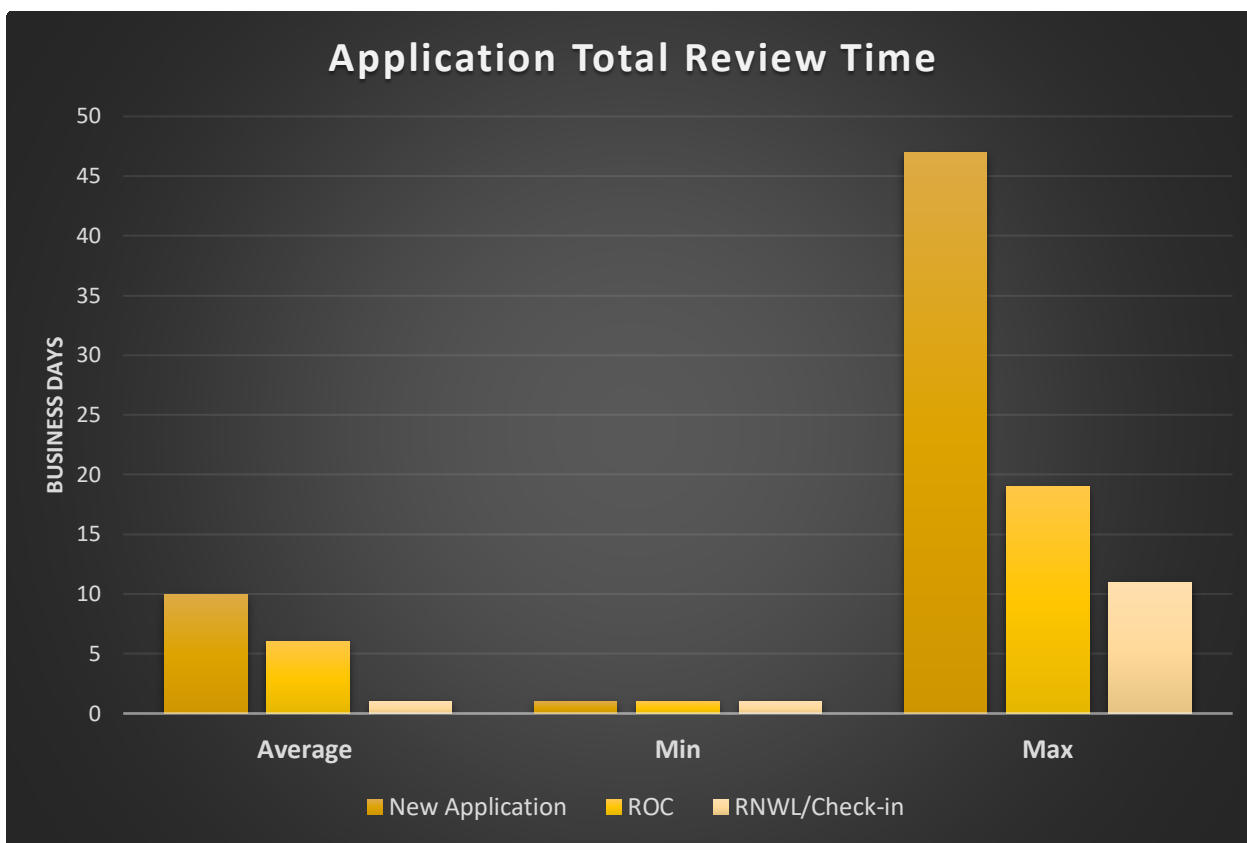

Number of withdrawn applications is down from 11% from FY 2020
Number of protocols deferred to another IRB is up from 1% to 6% from FY 2020

Processing and Review Times





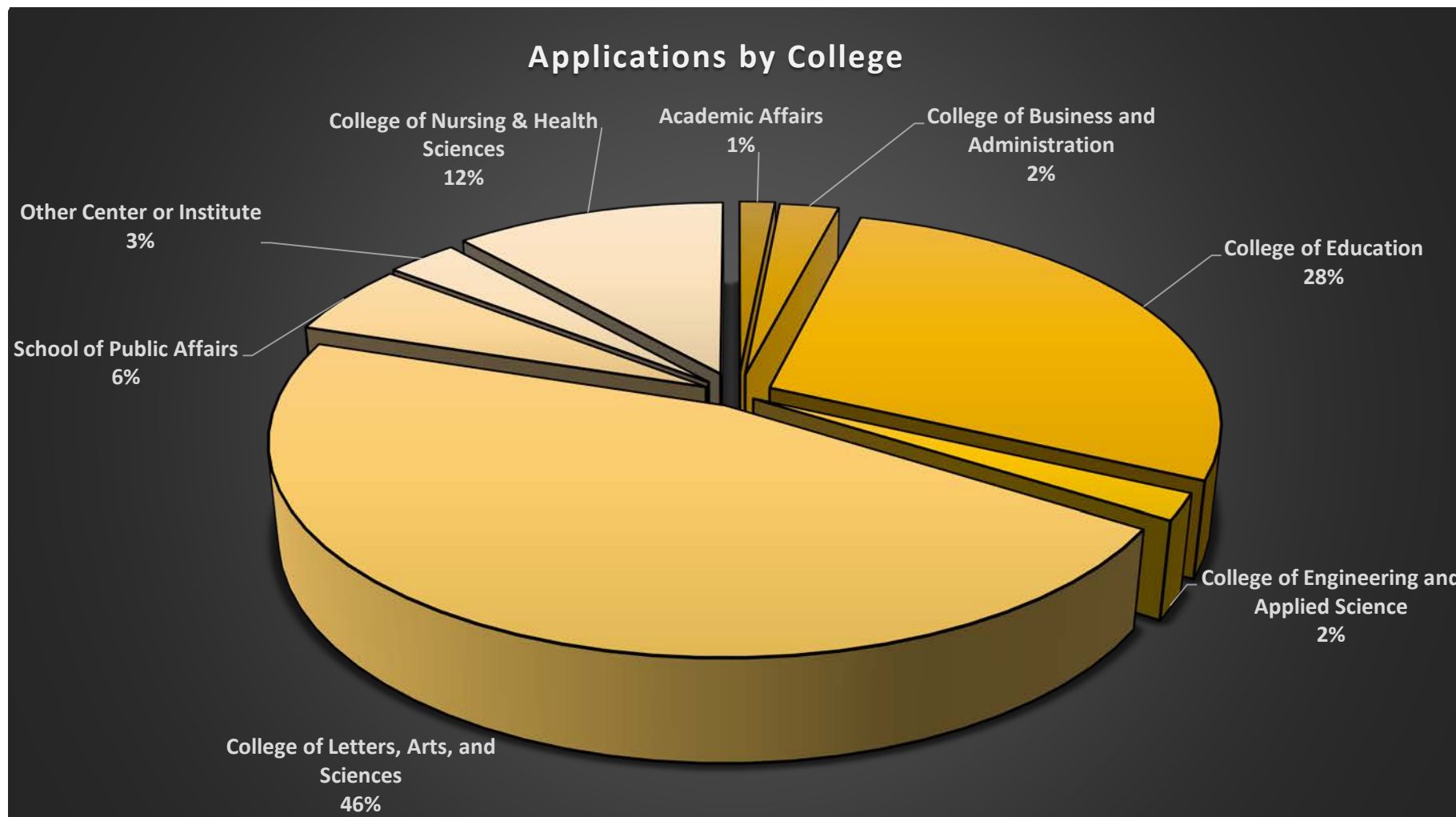

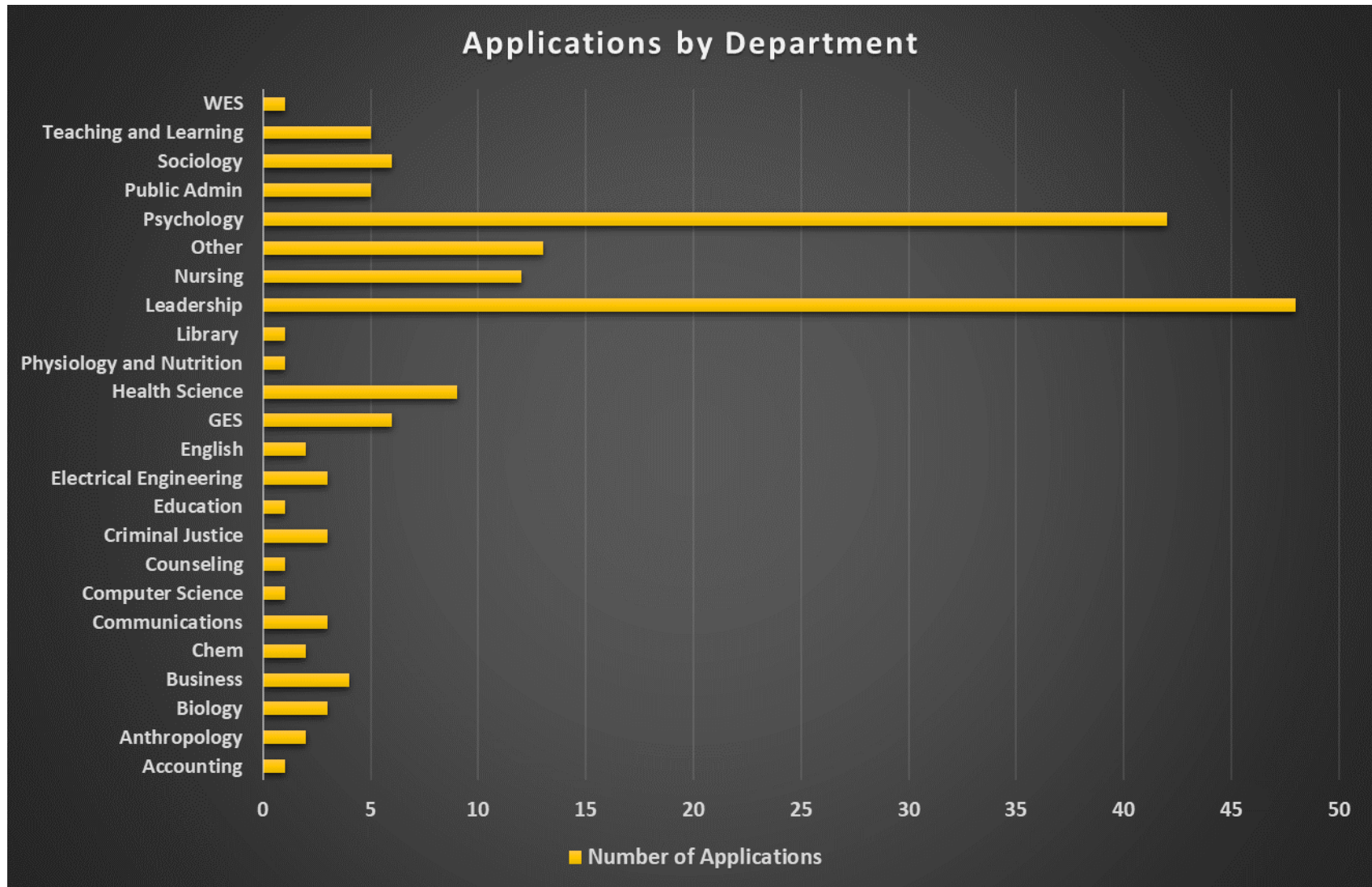
New applications are sent back 1.5 times on average for revisions by reviewers.

Applications taking more than 2 business days in office processing required attention from the PI (i.e., missing documents).

Majority of protocols are completely (63.52%) reviewed within 10 business days and 83.70% within 15 days.

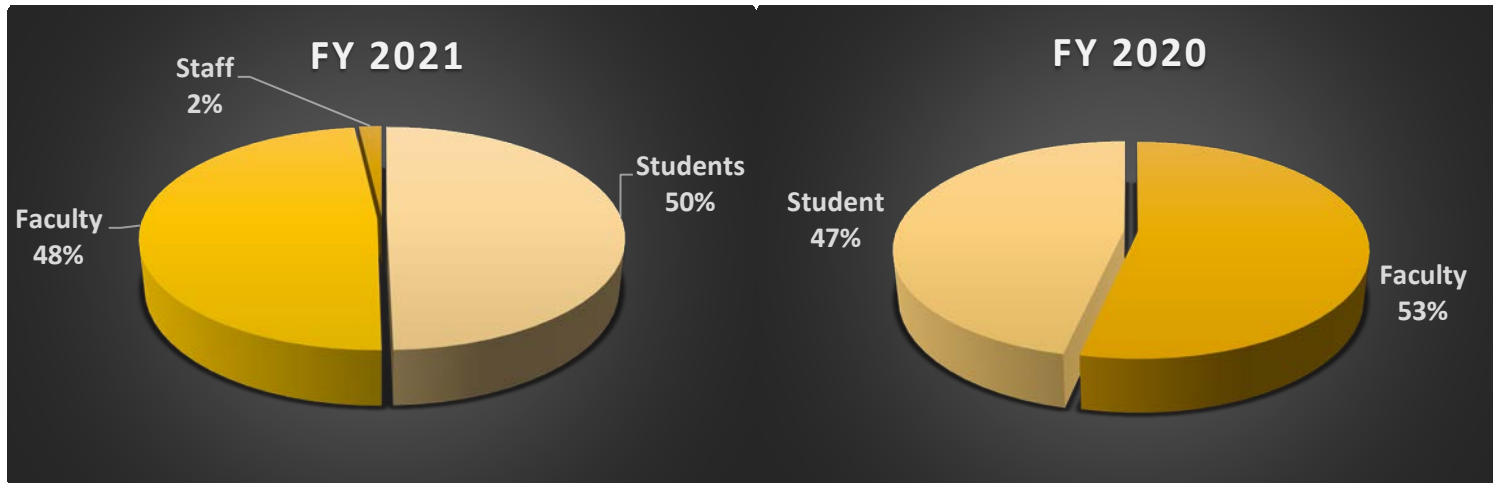
College and Department Breakdown



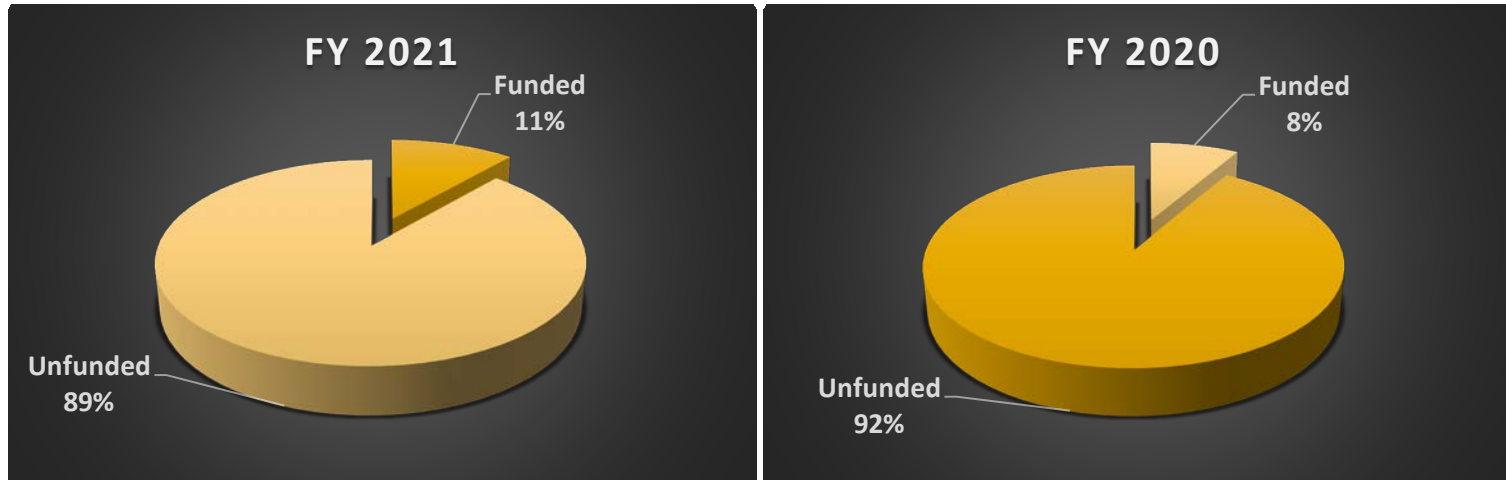


Historical Comparisons

New Applications by PI Affiliation

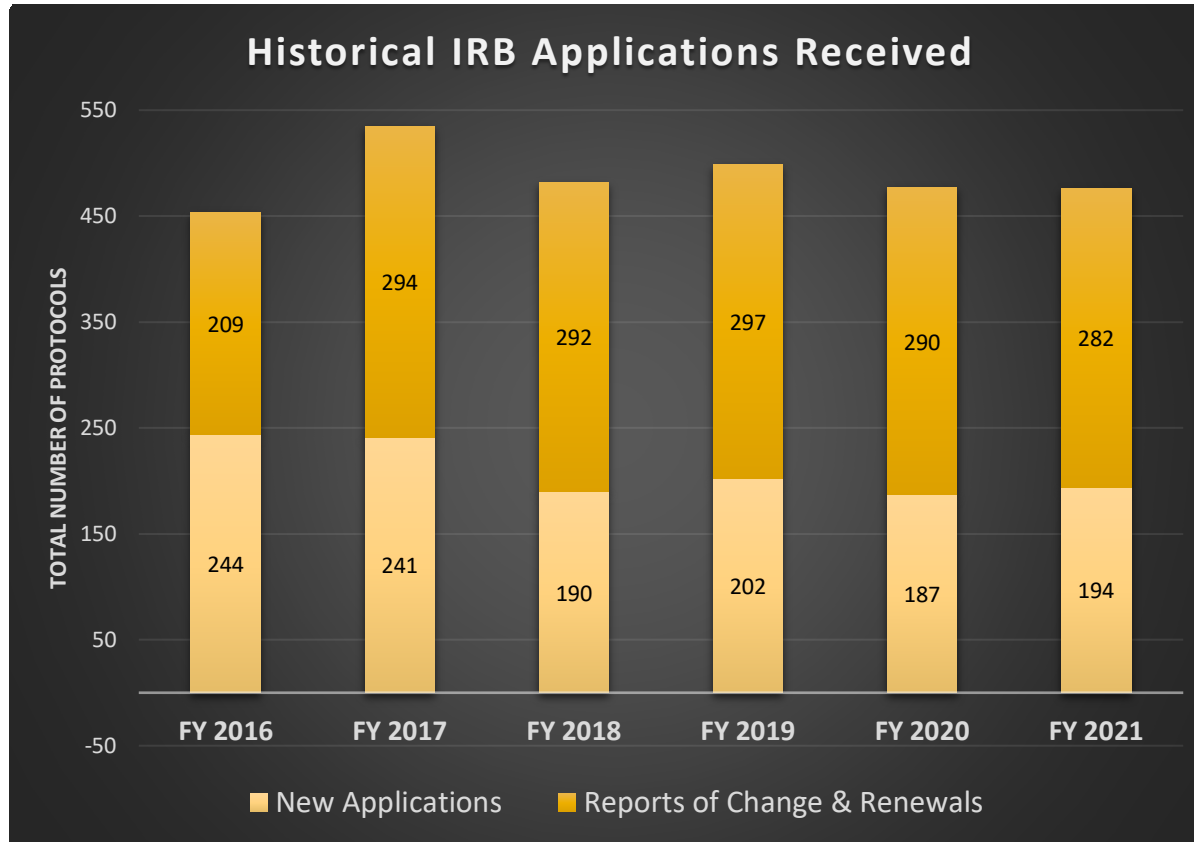


Funded vs. Unfunded Applications

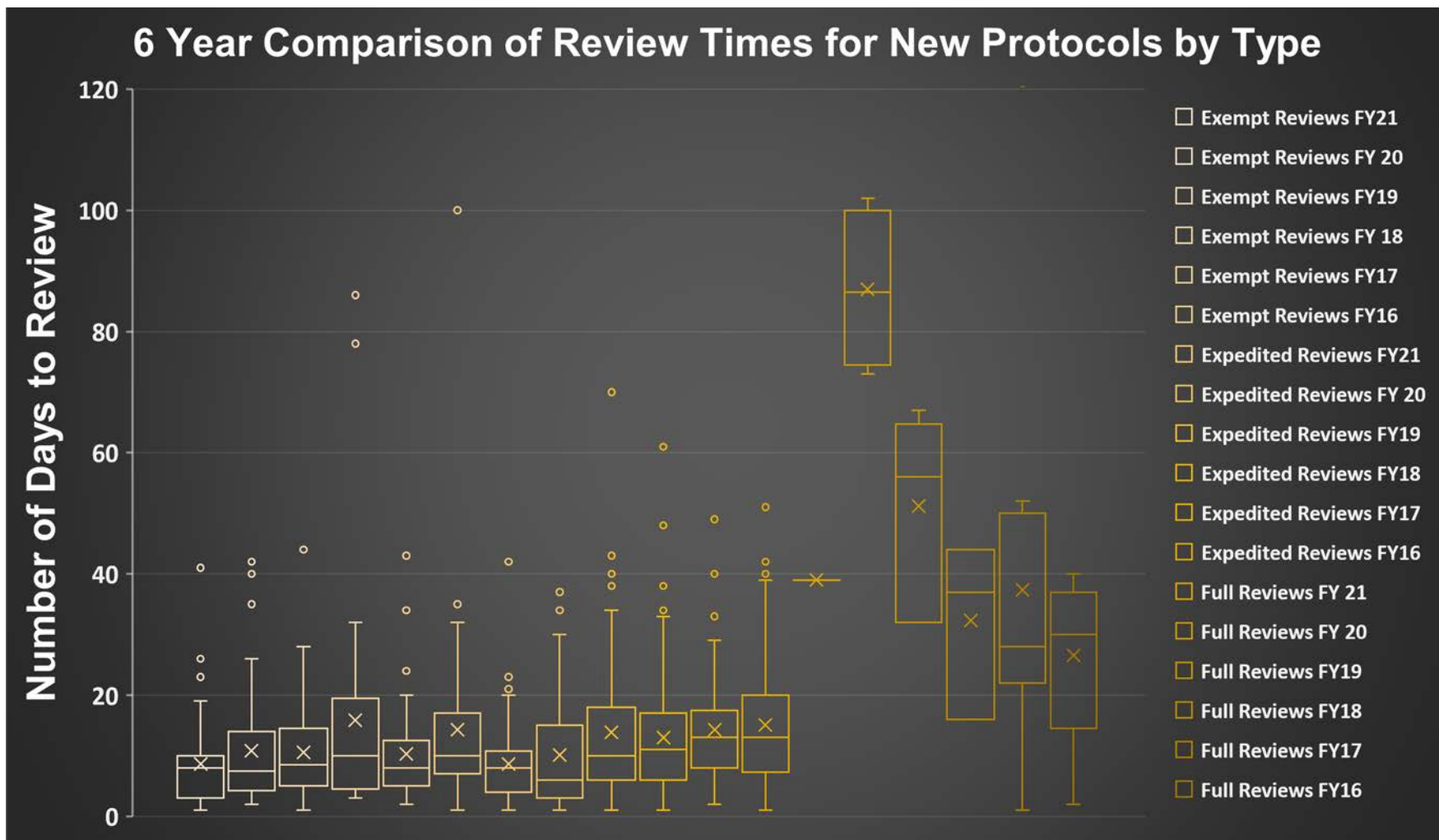


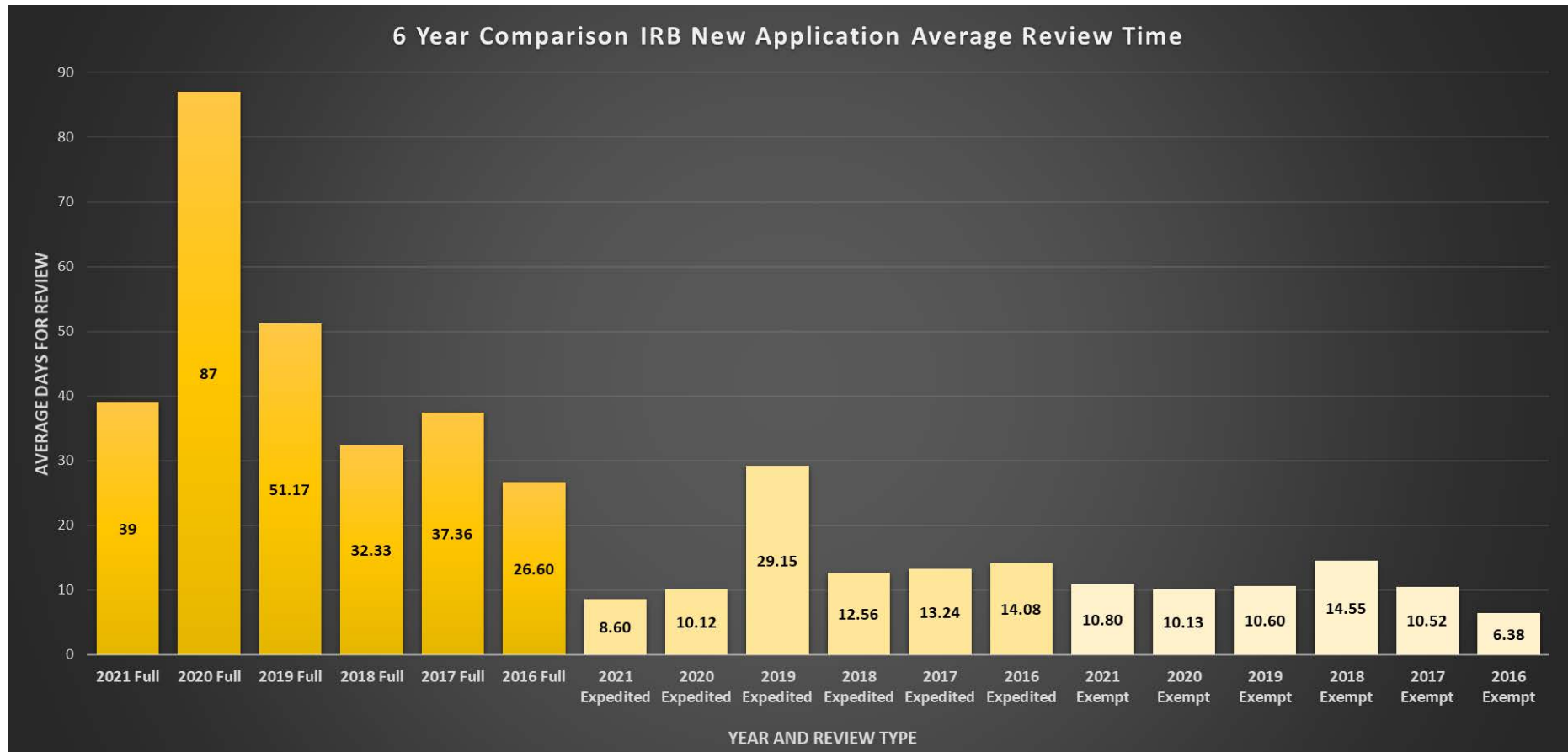

Total Application Comparison

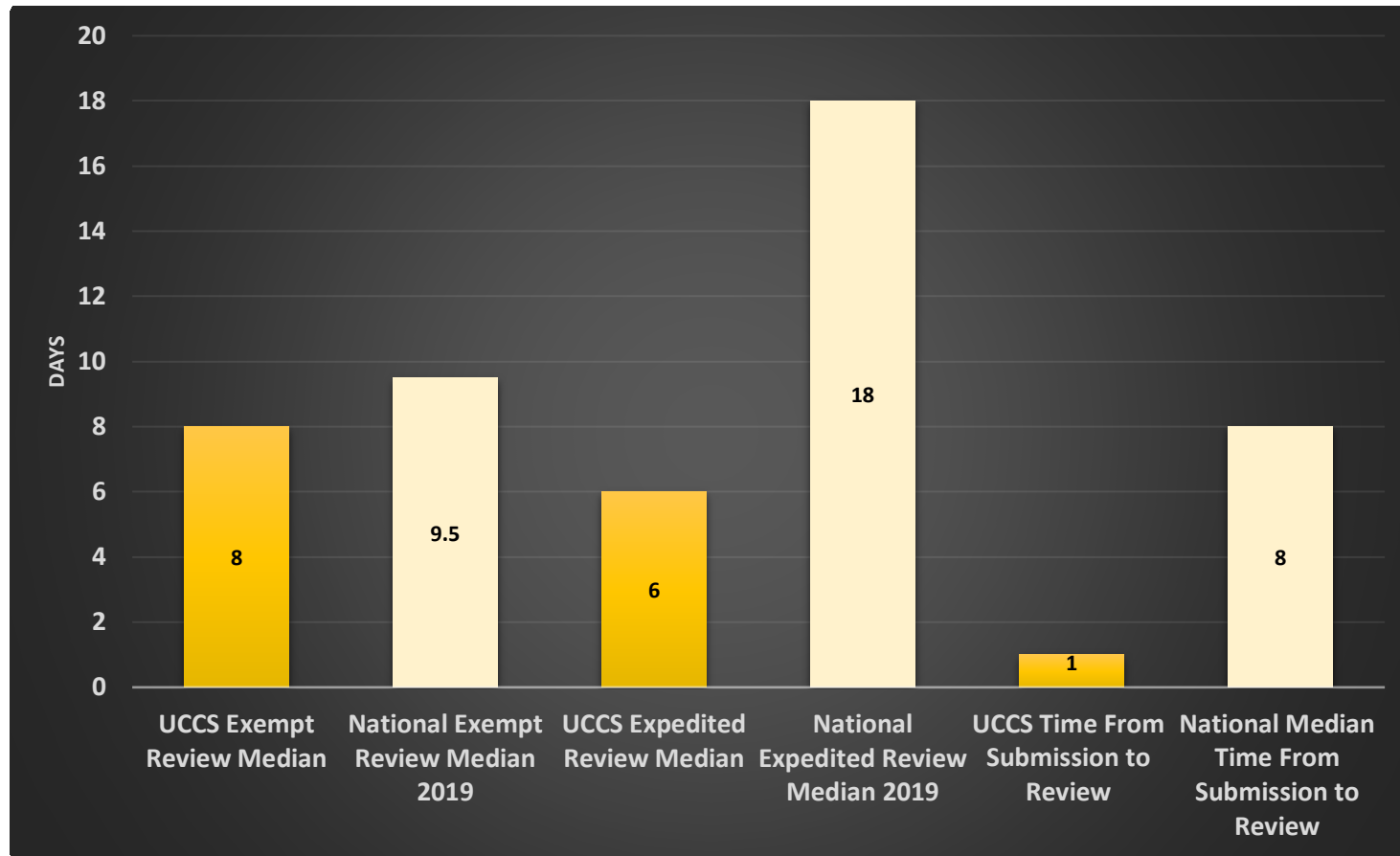


Review Time Comparisons

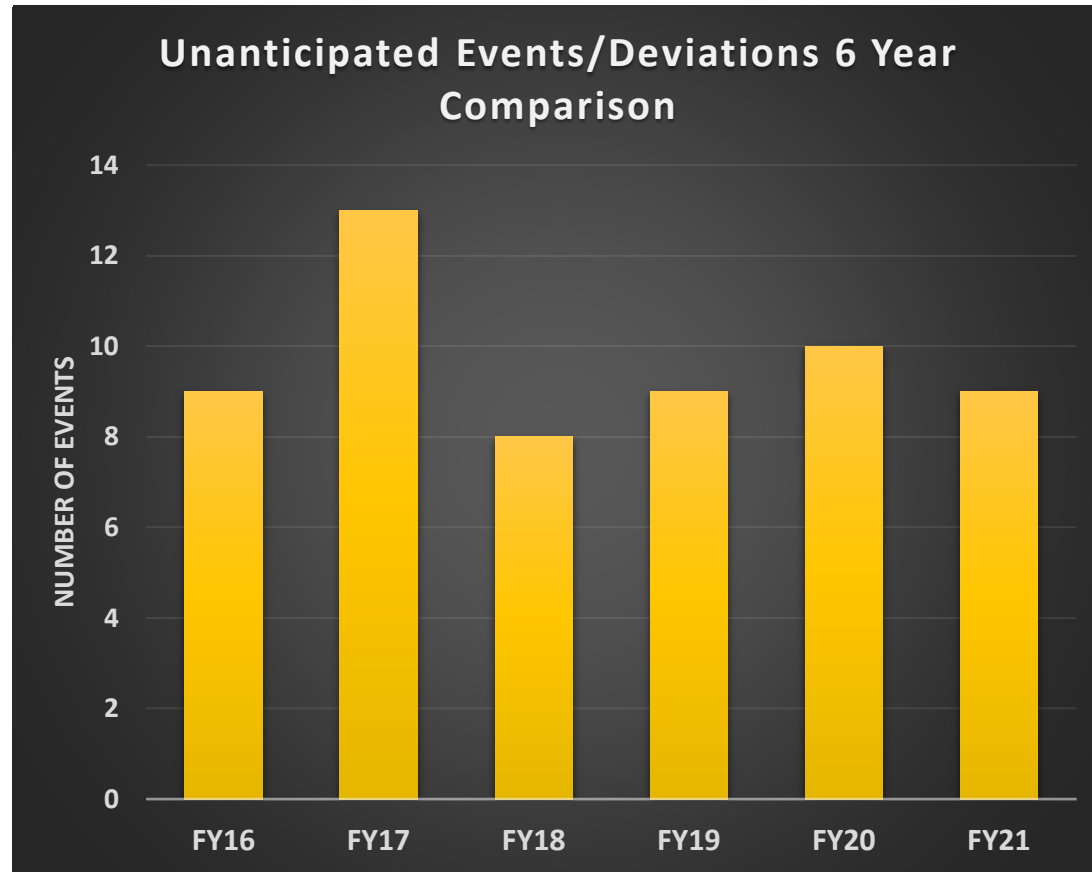




National Review Time Comparisons

Miscellaneous Facts

- 489 active protocols
- 2 approved protocols accessed FERPA data
- 1 active NIH clinical trial
- PIs take on average 8.3 days from when they start a new application to when they submit it to the IRB
- NSF main funder
- 108 new applications were for online studies
- 35 approved protocols at outside institutions (i.e., school districts, clinics, etc.)
- 4 studies approved at the Lane Center
- Decisions are sent within 1 business day of the office receiving them
- Applications are returned to data entry 1.7 times on average, and sent to reviewers 1.4 times, indicating a majority of applications require 1 revision
- Only 2 withdrawn applications
- 7 applications approved with children, 1 with pregnant women, 2 with prisoners, 1 international
